Open Board Positions: There are still open seats for a Vice-President and Secretary on the Board.

Financial Update:

We have not had any unexpected expenses and are tracking below our operating budget (not including projects) by about \$2,500. We have one home with open 2007 dues and 6 homes with open 2008 dues. 2009 dues notices will go out shortly. I am expecting an end of year cash balance of \$40,000.

ARB Report:

No report was given.

Other Business:

The Fence Easement

No proposal was available for submission at the meeting. The fence owners have committed to having a proposal available no later than Jan 31, 2010.

The Front Entrance

Todd Parrot from Turning Point Designs addressed the group reviewing his updated design proposal for the front.

Key points of the design:

- Create symmetry
- Move beds back from sidewalk a few feet to create a nice edge
- Low level evergreen coverings
- More permanence and elegance
- Easier Maintenance

- Up-lighting to highlight architectural features of wall
- Irrigation
- Under road boring and electrical conduit installation

Next steps

- 1. HOA approval of the plan
- 2. City site plan approval
 - We need a survey of the existing sign easement and the electronic survey file for Mr. Parrot to draft the plans for submission to the city.
 - Mr. Parrott believes we can file a simplified minor plan
 - Typically the process takes 3-5 weeks with the city and can include multiple comment and response iterations.
 - Get a sign permit
- 3. Estimated cost of full project about \$40,000
 - This is a rough estimate of cost: Demo \$2,400, preconstruction hardscape \$10,000, landscaping \$5,800, wall construction \$22,000.
 - Approved plans would be bid to at least 3 contractors
 - Includes the site plan approval process managed by Mr.
 Parrott, layout plan, dimension plan and a planting schedule

Proposals:

• Appropriate \$3,500 for Turning Point Design to develop and submit the site plan, including a survey, for submission and approval to the city of Durham. Unanimously approved.

Next Meeting:

The next meeting will likely be in early February to accommodate the fence owners timeline for submitting a fence proposal.

The 2010 budget will be submitted and approved at the next meeting. In the event we have a home sale in 2010 before the next meeting we will assume the 2010 dues will continue at \$205.
